

ByLaws for Fall 2011 competition

- It will be 25 overs per side competition.
- The following applies in accordance with the constitutional amendment made on August 20th 2011:
 - 2 points for each team in an abandon game
 - In order for a game to be considered a complete game 13 overs have to be completed in the 2nd innings.
- Umpire fees will be \$30 per team per game.
- The deadline to notify the EB and umpires if your team cannot make the Sunday game is midnight on Thursday before the game. An email must be sent in to eb@fsca.us. If you honor this then the umpire fee will be waived. Failure to honor this will result in the team not show up paying \$45 for that game.
- A player must play 3 games to qualify for playoffs. Must play means involved in the entire game unless injured. 12th man is not considered as a qualifying game. Both divisions.
- All players must be in team uniform or all white if no uniform available.
- Rain out games except playoffs will not be replayed. If more than 13 overs have been bowled in the 2nd innings then it's considered a complete game. If anything less than 78 legal deliveries in the 2nd innings then it's considered an abandoned game.
- Players list must be submitted before the start of the game, only submit the names of players present. If a player is on his way, then add that player when they show up as long as they show up before the cut off period. The cutoff period is before the start of the 2nd innings. A player who didn't field will only be allowed to bat at #7 or lower down the order.
- Registration deadline will be 8th October, 2011.
- Let's work on starting the game on time. We pay for 4 hours per game and if the morning games don't start on time then the afternoon game will not get their allotted 4 hours. This is something we have to really work hard on and everyone's cooperation is needed. Let's be fair to others.
